Norwalk Mayor's Ball beneficiaries announced

NORWALK — Mayor **Harry W. Rilling** announced that **Malta House** and Family & Children's Agency will receive proceeds from the 2017 Mayor's Ball.

Malta House, a nonprofit organization, has been serving homeless women and their children for nearly 20 years. It assists homeless women and their children by providing on-site counseling, financial education, and parental development followed by transitional and post-residential support. Malta House helps families reach self-sufficiency and independence.

Family & Children's Agency, a nonprofit organization, has been providing services to the most vulnerable members of the community since 1942. Its mission is to help families build better lives through the foster care and adoption programs. The agency also works to stabilize families by providing counseling and homeless services programs.

The Mayor's Ball, established as a nonprofit charitable institution, is held each January to benefit local charities. The 2017 Mayor's Ball will be held on Friday, Jan. 27, 2017, at 6:30 p.m., at the **Italian Center**, in Stamford. Tickets are available at \$120 per person. Tables of 10 can also be reserved.
